Industry journal names LIAI president deputy editor

Mitchell Kronenberg, Ph.D., president and scientific director of the La Jolla Institute for Allergy & Immunology, has been named a deputy editor of "The Journal of Immunology," one of the premier scientific journals for immunologists around the globe.

Incoming Editor-in-Chief Jeremy M. Boss, Ph.D., an Emory University professor, said deputy editors are accomplished, outstanding research scientists who are not only able to make the fairest decisions on a variety of manuscripts, but bring status and excellence to the journal.

Kronenberg has led LIAI, a nonprofit medical research institute, since 2003. He is an internationally recognized scientist and one of the most highly cited immunologists in the world. This distinction is held by less than one-half of 1 percent of all publishing scientific authors. In addition to his LIAI executive duties and new responsibilities with journal, Kronenberg conducts an active research program at LIAI, which is recognized as a leading immunology research institution.

Susan Swain, Ph.D., a member of LIAI's board of directors, also has been named as a deputy editor at "The Journal of Immunology." She and Kronenberg will be part of a team of 10 deputy editors, who review more than 4,000 manuscripts on scientific findings submitted annually for publication by researchers worldwide.

Swain is president emeritus and former president and director of the Trudeau Institute, an independent immunology research center in Saranac Lake, N.Y. She was recently appointed to the National Advisory Council on Aging (NACA), a prestigious group which provides input to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and other federal health leaders regarding scientific efforts to understand the nature of aging and to extend the healthy, active years of life. A prominent immunologist, she is also a former professor of biology at UC San Diego and a past president of the American Association of Immunologists.
