La Jolla Institute names Tsakopoulos to board

The La Jolla Institute for Allergy & Immunology's board elected Katina Tsakopoulos, a California businesswoman and community volunteer, as a new member at its June meeting.

A Rancho Santa Fe resident, Tsakopoulos is the managing partner of the Tsakopoulos Family Partnership, which manages real estate assets in Northern and Central California. The Tsakopoulos Family Partnership is closely affiliated with, and is a major partner of, **AKT Development Corp.**, one of California's largest land development companies.

Along with her business activities, Tsakopoulos has also been active with several charities focused on children's issues.

A native of Sacramento, Tsakopoulos moved to Rancho Santa Fe in 2000 and has been involved as an activist on children's issues both in Sacramento and locally. Over the years, her activities have included serving on the founding board of the Mercy Perinatal Recovery Network, an organization affiliated with Mercy Hospital in Sacramento. The network assists pregnant women and new mothers battling substance abuse, helping them learn to overcome their addictions, give birth to healthier babies and prevent their children from being placed in foster care. Tsakopoulos served on the board for five years, including two years as chairwoman.

She also has worked with Children Uniting Nations, a program linking children in foster care with mentors from the community. In addition, she served for several years as chairwoman for Red Ribbon week, a national anti-drug program, at Earl Warren Middle School in San Diego.
